TAMTA honors Philelle McBrayer

At the centennial celebration of Tulsa Area Music Teachers Association on September 28, Philelle McBrayer was the one current member selected for a special "member profile," and Miriam Spindler Lynch was the one past member honored.

Philelle is a 42-year member of TAMTA and has been president of Texas Music Teachers Association and Oklahoma Music Teachers Association. She is a longtime member of Tulsa Alumnae Chapter. Karen Harrington read the TAMTA member profile of Philelle.


Several other SAI members are members of TAMTA.

TAMTA was founded in October 1919. One of the two cofounders was Nelle Garbutt Spindler, mother of Miriam.

In Memoriam: Jodi Powell

Glenda Jo Balint Powell, whom we have lovingly called Jodi, was initiated by Alpha Zeta Chapter at Oklahoma City University on March 15, 1949. She majored in voice and piano, but teaching elementary music was her career path.

Jodi affiliated with Tulsa Alumnae Chapter on October 27, 1970, and with the exception of a few years here and there when she was an associate member, Jodi held full membership in the chapter. She was awarded the Sword of Honor by the chapter.



Jodi and her husband, SAI Friend of the Arts Charles Powell, first performed together for Tulsa Alumnae chapter on a musicale on October 24, 2006, the beginning of a series of piano/clarinet appearances much appreciated by their alum audiences over the years. Their final performance for us was being part of the musicale held in conjunction with Tulsa Alumnae Chapter's 75th Anniversary celebration last February.

Jodi loved playing piano duets and teamed up with several of our other chapter pianists where the two musicians would spend hours playing duets, just for the fun of it. Jodi and Charlie loved singing with us when we visited senior citizen residences for Christmas caroling each December. Jodi's costume for these caroling events, complete with faux braids on her cap, helped make the caroling parties even more special.

A very precious gift to Tulsa Alumnae Chapter, hand made by Jodi, is the lovely rose tablecloth which we use for very special occasions.

A seventy-year member of SAI, Jodi epitomized the words expressed in "So Near, So Dear"----to her, SAI was "nearer and dearer as years go by." She departed this life on September 14, 2019 at the age of 90 years.
