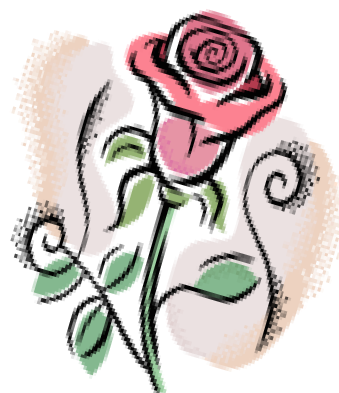


Tulsa Patroness Chapter Communications, Sue Shadley

Meet Genevieve Palmer

Fraternity Education with Sue Amstutz

Genevieve Palmer was a mainstay in Tulsa Alumnae activities throughout the 1950s, 1960s, and early 1970s. She served as president of the Alumnae Chapter from 1955 - 1957. As one of Sigma Gamma's alumnae advisors, she and her co-advisor Maxine Myers were regular visitors to the TU campus to lend a hand, give support, and provide wise counsel to the college chapter members. When the entire Sigma Gamma Chapter was invited to perform a mini-musical at the Dinner of Honors at SAI's 1959 National Convention in San Francisco, Genevieve not only got involved in arranging the logistics for travel, housing, and performance attire for the young ladies, but she herself joined the entourage who accompanied Sigma Gamma to California. Following Genevieve's passing in 1973, her family made a contribution in her memory to Tulsa Alumnae Chapter, which became the basis for the Genevieve Palmer Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship provides convention expenses for a non-delegate college member from Sigma Gamma to attend SAI's triennial convention. The lighted badge, still in use by Tulsa Alumnae during Formal Meetings, was a gift from Robert and Genevieve Palmer; there is a small brass plaque on the back of the badge which reminds us of the Palmers' belief in Sigma Alpha Iota.
