Tulsa Alumnae Chapter is saddened to report the passing on November 5, 2019, of one of our Charter members, Helen Reecher. A piano major, Helen was a 1940 initiate of Sigma Gamma Chapter at TU. She was one of forty-nine SAIs who formed the charter group when Tulsa Alumnae Chapter was



installed on November 9, 1943. Helen was ninetynine years old at the time of her passing. She and her husband, the late Marvin Reecher, were important in the church music community in Tulsa, he as long-time Minister of Music at Boston Avenue United Methodist Church, and she as co-founder of the children's graded choir program at the church.

The SAI Memorial Ritual for Helen will take place at the Tulsa Alumnae Chapter's Formal Meeting in January, 2020.
